



Terms of Use for Visiting the Collection

The aim of the department *Information and Documentation*, located at the **KJTZ - Kinder- und Jugendtheaterzentrum in der Bundesrepublik Deutschland (in English: Children and Young People's Theatre Centre in the Federal Republic of Germany) in Frankfurt am Main** is the collection and provision of material on the performing arts for young audiences for research and knowledge transfer as well as the promotion of artistic work and cultural education. The documents are indexed and accessible to the public. However, we would like to ask visitors to contact the department *Information and Documentation* in advance so that we can prepare your visit to the collection and make the required materials available on time. For your own research, the online catalogue with references to literature as well as overviews of the individual collection parts is available on the website.

On their first visit to the collection, a data sheet is created and the visitors are provided with a reading card. This is followed by an introduction by the staff on the use of the collection and the documentation of the research in joint agreement. Bags and jackets must be left in the cloakroom, food and drinks are not allowed in the collection space. Visitors have free access to the library, with the exception of the periodical magazine, the media library and the archive attached to the library. The archives and audio-visual media (DVDs, CDs, videos, tapes, records) are presented to the visitors by appointment. The necessary devices are available on site for playing back the media. The items in the collection are present holdings and therefore cannot be lend. The general use of the collection follows the requirements of the Hessian Archives Act. It is within the scope of the rights of use, personality and copyright and may also be restricted by measures for the protection und preservation of the collection materials. The use of the *Archive of the Children's and Youth Theatre in the GDR* is unfortunately not possible at the moment.

By arrangement, documents can be scanned by the staff of the department *Information and Documentation*, copies may be made by the visitors themselves. The copies (DIN A4 format) cost 0.10 € per sheet. In the library, copying is limited to a maximum of 15% of a copyrighted work. Play texts and magazines may not be reproduced. The exception to this is the reproduction of copyrighted works for private use, which may take place without the prior permission of the author. The copying of archival material submitted for inspection always requires the permission of the staff of the department *Information and Documentation*.

The public disclosure or transfer of the reproductions to third parties as well as any duplication for the purpose of passing on or transferring to third parties is prohibited. The following applies: Reproduction and publication from our holdings is only possible upon presentation of the declaration of consent of the authors. Authors are contacted by the *Children's and Youth Theatre Centre* when reproductions are commissioned. The information on the exploitation rights of the media can be provided on request and is also listed in the online catalogue (www.kjtz-online.de).
